MACROINVERTEBRATES

Under the surface of the River there is another whole world of life. Investigate what kinds of things live there.



TURTLES / YABBIES

Learn about short necked turtles, yabbies and the endangered Murray River crayfish. Take a look at the school pond where our long necked turtles live.
