## POSSIBLE WORKSHOPS INCLUDE:

### DANNY THE DRIP

Follow a drop of water down the River Murray and learn about what he encounters.

### BIRDS OF KINGSTON ON MURRAY

Come and learn about the abundant bird life that thrives along our beautiful river. Calls, habitat, habits and more.



### MACROINVERTEBRATES

Under the surface of the River there is whole other world of life. Investigate what kinds of things live there and what they tell us about the River's health.

### TURTLES / YABBIES

Learn about short necked turtles, yabbies and the endangered Murray River crayfish. Take a look at the school pond where our long-necked turtles live.



### BANROCK STATION

Head out to Banrock Station on the Kingston on Murray bus and enjoy a tour of their wetlands and wildlife with the Banrock Ranger.

### RIVER FISH

Pest or Pal? Learn about our native fish, their intriguing habits and the challenges they face from unwelcome guests.

### CANOE TRIPS
